### Awards:



## Entry Instructions

**Artist** may enter up to two pieces of work. They may be of any category, medium and style. Artwork must be two dimensional, **original** and **not previously shown in OSA gallery**. **No class generated work.**

Photography & Sculpture not accepted.

**Artists** who are juried into the show are requested to attend the reception. **Juried artists are required to gallery sit at least once during the month of the show.**

### Framing:

**Mats:** white or off-white, colored liners allowed, no larger than a quarter inch.

**Must** be framed simple, not ornate.

**Wrapped** canvases, and cradle boards minimum 1 ½ " deep, and sides painted

**Glass** and mat must be clean and free from hair and lint.

**Flat** hangers or D Rings only, no screw eyes or saw tooth hangers. At least 5 lb wire: mount about one third down frame

**Maximum** framed outside dimensions **must not exceed 48"** on any side.

**Minimum** outside dimensions **must not be less than 11"** on any one side.

**Entries** larger than 22"x28" must use Plexiglas™ in place of glass.

**Entries not meeting these specifications will not be accepted.**

## Chris Stubbs 2017 Juror

Chris has won numerous awards locally in the Watercolor Society of Oregon, including five People's Choice awards. She is a **Signature Member** of the **National Watercolor Society, Northwest Watercolor Society and Western Federation of Watercolor Societies**, winning awards for her paintings in both NWWWS and Western Federation of Watercolor Societies.

Currently working as a portrait artist, Chris originally majored in Nursing at Duke University. From there she spent three decades as the wife and helpmate of a career Naval Officer and mother of two. At age 16, Chris was introduced to watercolor and that remains her medium of choice to this day.

Chris has developed her watercolor techniques by compiling lessons from multiple workshops over the past two decades. She has always been fascinated by peoples' stories **and in capturing that story when painting their portraits. For her paintings to "live" there must be a story behind the painting.**

She has been teaching portrait painting in Oregon for the past 9 years, as well as nationally. In 2016 she was one of the featured instructors at Kanuaga Watermedia Workshop in Hendersonville, NC. Chris loves teaching and the interaction she has with her students. **She is always interested in giving away what she has learned and watching others mature in their ability to master this magical medium.**
